

If you wish to enjoy the true beauty of nature, experience the ancient cultural and historical monuments while riding a bicycle along the exceptionally indented and exciting coastline or explore the secrets of the countryside, our region is the right place for you! Two national parks, Krka and Kornati, a multitude of islands and islets, cultural and historical monuments, numerous archaeological sites, protected landscapes, exciting towns both on the coast and in the countryside will provide you with countless opportunities for an active holiday.

If you go for a ride in Šibenik's hinterland, you will discover ancient fortresses around the river Krka, archaeological sites Burnum, Bribirska Glavica and Danilo with remains dating from the prehistoric era, you will feel the spirit of the Dalmatian villages and experience the way of life as it once was.

Explore the mountain Dinara, with the highest peak in Croatia (1831 m), by taking a light walk or by cycling along the adrenaline packed bicycle trails, and on the way visit the historical towns Knin and Drniš, and a unique hydrogeological monument of nature, the spring of the river Cetina.

Cycling along the trails of the Nature Park Vransko jezero (Lake Vrana) will enable you to see the rare bird species inhabiting this area, and you can continue your journey towards the island of Murter and experience the authenticity

of small fishing villages. Passing by the centuries old drywalls and olive groves, you will reach Tribunj and Vodice, where you will find a rich gastronomic offer. The rest of the way will take you to the pearl of Dalmatia - the Renaissance town of Šibenik, which is, with its 15th century Cathedral of St James (Katedrala sv. Jakova) protected by UNESCO, and with its fortresses, considered one of the most beautiful Mediterranean towns. We should not forget Primošten and Rogoznica – small fishing villages with numerous legends and tales.

With more than 2450 km of well maintained routes in the region, you can enjoy the diverse offer – whether you want to cycle along the coast and enjoy the sea breeze, or take the countryside routes and get to know forest and mountain trails, vineyards and olive groves, or you want to experience high adrenaline mountain trails and explore the canyons of the rivers Krka or Čikola, you can find all that and more in the Šibenik-Knin region. A mild Mediterranean climate, pleasant temperatures and relatively low rainfall make this region an ideal destination for an active holiday. A large number of cycling events, various mountain bike races, themed bicycle events, XC marathons, Winter League for adults and children provide everyone, whether amateur or professional, big or small, with an opportunity to try their competitive ambitions.

ŠIBENIK

The oldest Croatian town on the Adriatic coast, first mentioned in 1066. Šibenik is one of the largest and best preserved medieval towns. The largest part of its treasures can be seen by walking the ancient streets, visiting museums and churches that hide unexpected surprises and valuable spiritual experiences. Over 20 religious monuments and 17 mansions in the old town centre.

The Cathedral of St. James (Katedrala sv. Jakova) is unique in the world – a cultural and historical pearl protected by UNESCO. Šibenik is a child friendly city with many festivals, a treasure chest of musical heritage and historical music instruments. Šibenik is the city of fortresses – the guardians of Šibenik's history – (Barone, St Michael (sv. Mihovil), St John (sv. Ivan) and St Nicholas (sv. Nikola).

From the sea, Šibenik is guarded by St Nicholas' Fortress

(Tvrđava sv. Nikole) and St Anthony's Channel (Kanal sv. Ante), with a beautiful promenade that, in addition to many cultural and natural values, offers different opportunities for sports and recreation. Danilo – Rider – one of the most significant archaeological sites in Croatia. The Hawk Centre (Sokolarski centar).

The islands of Kaprije, Žirje, Zlarin, Krapanj.

BRODARICA

A small settlement near Šibenik, and the associated island of Krapanj – the lowest inhabited island in the Adriatic Sea, known for the harvesting of sea sponges and for scuba diving

GREBAŠTICA

A quiet place between Šibenik and Primošten, ideal for family holidays; beautiful beaches in a series of bays around which the settlement is situated the preserved 15th century defensive stone wall on the peninsula Oštrica, built for protection against Ottoman attacks, is today one of the cultural monuments protected by the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Croatia.

the spring of drinking water "Kanela"; the cave Golubinka (Pigeons' Cave), the habitat of rock pigeons, directly connected to the sea via underground channels.

The Church of St Mary, which is unique for being a dual, functionally connected, religious monument dates back to the 15th century, and it has been entered in the register of cultural monuments of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Croatia.

ZLARIN

The island of corals, where they are even today manually processing corals and making jewellery. Because of the beauty of its nature and the crystal clear sea, Zlarin is sometimes called "the golden island" (insula auri).

The largest cultural monument in Zlarin is the Fraternity

Gospe od Rašelje (Bratovština Gospe od Rašelje), founded 34 years before Colombo discovered America. The baroque Church of Mary's Ascension (Crkva Uzašašća Marijina) from 1740.

Churches of St Rocco (sv. Roko) and St Simeon (sv. Šime) are today museums of Zlarin's maritime history, and three sacrament chapels. The adjoining island of Obonjan, a luxury camping party destination.

ŽIRJE

The most distant inhabited island of the Šibenik archipelago, numerous beautiful bays, a favourite spot for nautical tourists. Well maintained bicycle trails, traditional cyclefest "Đir za Žir" (Tour for Acorn).

BILICE

A small settlement in the hinterland of Šibenik, the archaeological site of a basilica from the 5th and 6th century (excavations in progress).

"Šuplja gromila" - archaeological site.

Viewpoint Pomišalj, where the local church and cemetery are located.

Lake Prokljan (Prokljansko jezero).







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

PRIMOŠTEN

It was a small fishing settlement in the past, situated on an islet and connected to the mainland with a bridge, thus receiving its name (the verb primostiti - to bridge).

Surrounded by seven islets, typical Mediterranean culture, beautiful beaches.

Numerous agrotourism households in the countryside, situated close to bicycle trails – Jurlinovi Dvori, Galjin Dvor, Šarićevi Dvori, Oaza Jelinjak, Baćulovi Dvori.

Famous vineyards of Primošten's indigenous grape variety Babić Bucavac.

The Church of St Rocco (sv. Roko), Primošten. Many families' votive chapels.

ROGOZNICA

A quiet and warm Mediterranean town situated in the

southmost part of the region.

The lake Dragon's Eye (jezero Zmajevo Oko), a geohydromorphological phenomenon on the eastern Adriatic coast — there are many legends about this lake, one of them about the dragon Murin, according to which if two people who are in love bathe in the Dragon's Eye, they will be faithful to each other for the rest of their lives and their marriage will be blessed.

Cape Planka (rt Planka), the most outstretched part of the eastern coast of the Adriatic Sea that is a climate divider between the northern and southern Adriatic.

The Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Heaven (Crkva Uznesenja Blažene Djevice Marije na Nebo), built in the 17th century in the honour of St Nicholas.

a museum in the deep blue sea.

Our Lady of the Chapel, the miraculous guardian of Rogoznica, whose painting is kept in the chapel on the cape Gradina. Aquarium in the open sea.

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

TRIBUNJ

A small picturesque town in the heart of the Šibenik-Knin riviera

A rich hinterland with numerous bicycle and trekking trails leading to several beautiful viewpoints, the Church of St Rocco (sv. Roko) and Kugine Stope. Olive Paths through vineyards and olive groves along which you can find well preserved traditional farmers' houses called bunje. The islands of Lukovnjak and Logorun.

PIROVAC

A medieval settlement and the fortification of the oldest Croatian noblemen.

Its old name, Zloselo, was derived from the word Slossein,



meaning little castle (Dvorčić), of which there are several in the town and its surroundings Rich cultural and historical heritage Situated in a bay 12 km deep, a well known bathing site with healing mud Makirina.

Numerous bicycle trails along the Nature Park Vransko jezero.

OTOK MURTER

The largest inhabited island in the Šibenik-Knin County, with four settlements: Murter – Kornati, Betina, Jezera and Tisno, connected to the mainland by a bridge in Tisno.

MURTER

The largest settlement on the island, inhabited in the prehistoric era and in the times of the Illyrians. Remains of Roman structures and remains of the Roman settlement Colentum were found at the foot of the hill Gradina, in the Hramina cove and elsewhere. National Park Kornati.

Numerous events, of which the most famous is the regatta Latinsko Idro (Latin Sail).

Betina – a picturesque, autochthonous and traditional village known for its shipbuilders or "kalafati", and the centre of wooden shipbuilding.

JEZERA

The town of seafarers, fishermen and divers, inhabited since the Antiquity, its name comes from the two lakes, Lokva and Blato, which dry up in the summer months.

Rich religious and folk cultural and historical heritage KUD Koledišće - a folk ensemble, the keeper of non-material cultural heritage.

Sports and recreational event "Big Game Fishing" Natural paths and bays ideal for walking, cycling and recreation.

RFTINA

A picturesque, autochthonous and traditional village known for its shipbuilders or "kalafati", and the centre of wooden shipbuilding.

Museum of Wooden Shipbuilding.

Numerous opportunities for an active holiday. Regatta for the Soul and Body (Regata za dušu i tilo).

TISN0

A "big city on a small scale", an urban centre with lovely stone houses, churches, historical and cultural sites. The place where the island of Murter is connected to the mainland. Rich gastronomic offer. Numerous festivals, of which the most famous is the Garden Festival.

SKRADIN

The antique town Skradin - the oldest town in the region, inhabited since the Neolithic period – almost 6,000 years ago. The capital of the Illyrian Liburnia, the Roman Scardona, the early Christian diocese from the 4th century and the capital of medieval Croatia in the 14th century.

The sea entrance to the National Park Krka and a favourite nautical destination.

A Franciscan monastery with a rich collection on the island of Visovac.

Bribir, the prehistoric fortification of the Liburnians, the Roman Varvaria and the medieval town of the Croatian noble family Šubić, today the most famous Croatian archaeological site.











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
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DRNIŠ

A small town in the Dalmatian hinterland known for its famous Drniš prosciutto, in the honour of which the International Festival of Prosciutto is organised every year. The region of Ivan Meštrović's childhood, with the Church of the Holy Redeemer – the Meštrović family mausoleum. Meštrović's fountain The Spring of Life (Vrelo života) and other works are exhibited as public monuments in Drniš. Historical tour of the town, from the Town Museum, over Stara Mlinica in the canyon of the river Čikola, to the fortress Gradina.

Medieval fortresses in the canyons of the rivers Čikola and Krka - the fortress Gradina in Drniš and the system of fortifications Ključica, Kamičak, Bogočin, Nečven and Trošenj. NP Krka - the waterfall Roški slap.

The Franciscan Monastery of the Mother of Mercy and the Church of Our Lady of Visovac on the small island of Visovac.

Trekking trail Stinice – the waterfall Roški slap – the cave Oziđana along the river Krka.

Protected landscape of the canyon of the river Čikola Canyoning, free climbing, hiking trail and zip-line The mountain Promina (1148 m) with a mountain lodge, an educational trail and a view of the Kornati Islands.

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
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KNIN

The royal historical town on 7 rivers. The highest peak in Croatia, Dinara, at 1831 m. The second largest military fortification in Europe - the Knin fortress - a living cultural monument with museums, exhibitions and a restaurant. The charming river Krka with a dedicated picnic site, a recreational park and a hiking-bicycle trail.

A natural phenomenon, waterfall Krčić - the romantic

canyon Krčić with its waterfalls and mills is where one meets with the almost untouched nature. The most important archaeological site in Croatia – Biskupija. The Church of Our Lady of the Great Croatian Baptismal Vow (Crkva Gospe Velikog Hrvatskog Krsnog Zavjeta) named after the ancient figure of St Mary in Croatia that was found in Biskupija.

The event "The Days of Zvonimir", a return to medieval times during the reign of King Zvonimir.
