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Opatija Riviera







The Opatija Riviera, situated at the foot of mighty Mount Učka and adorned by palms and camellias, has been the cradle of Croatian tourism ever since the mid-19th century. The magnificent architecture of its elegant villas, and its lush parks and mild climate made it the ideal health tourism destination.

Things to see:

Opatija's Lungomare, stretching from Volosko to Lovran and bordered by lush greenery and 19th-century villas, is one of the most beautiful coastal promenades in the Mediterranean.

Things to do:

Visit the Croatian Museum of Tourism in Opatija's famous Villa Angiolina and find out more about the beginnings and importance of tourism in this area.

Climb the peak of Mount Učka, which rises 1,401 metres above sea level, and enjoy unforgettable views of the area.

Rijeka Region

Surrender to the sun and crystal clear sea on the area's sand and pebble beaches or in some quiet, romantic spot.

Take a walk in the Heavenly Labyrinths and Mediterranean Labyrinth of Love and fill yourself with positive energy.

Picturesque mountains, quiet ancient forests, magnificent karst caves and rocks, beautiful lakes and rivers – in this area, you can forget the hustle and bustle of the city for a while and experience true harmony with nature. In the past, this wooded area was so inaccessible that the might of the Roman Empire could not seize it. It was even known as the Devil's Garden (*Hortus Diabolicus*). Today, however, Gorski kotar is a priceless natural treasure and popular excursion destination.

Things to see:

Risnjak National Park and the source of the River Kupa is a unique area and home to all three European large carnivores: the wolf, bear and lynx.

Things to do:

Pass beneath the 70-metre-high waterfall of Zeleni Vir, walk the 800-metre-long gorge of Vražji Prolaz, and descend into Croatia's deepest cave – Lokvarka.

Take a ride on the Gorski kotar Bike Route, a path full of wild romance.

Take part in picking, processing and sampling the fruits of the mountains.





Island of Cres





Cres is an island distinguished by its extraordinarily rich flora and fauna, which makes it the perfect destination for visitors who want to enjoy unspoilt nature. The island is one of the last habitats of the rare griffon vulture. The magnificent Lake Vrana and the island's more than 1,300 relict and endemic plants add to the attractiveness of this charming Mediterranean island.

Things to see:

Lubenice is an ancient small town built on top of a 378-metre-high cliff above the sea. Its history dates back 4,000 years and it is a real wonder of rural Croatian architecture.

Things to do:

Admire the view of the griffon vultures' impressive flight.

Take a walk in the fabulous Tramontana area – an oasis of powerful, unbridled nature.

Experience the Blue Cave, a natural phenomenon that will take your breath away.

Island of Lošinj





The island of Lošinj is also known as the Island of Vitality. Thanks to its mild Mediterranean climate, pine forests, fresh air and numerous walking paths, this is the ideal destination to invigorate body and soul. A visit to Lošinj allows you to experience true harmony with nature.

Things to see:

The Apoxyomenos is an ancient bronze statue of an athlete from the early 1st century. It was found on the seabed between the small island of Vele Orjule and the island of Lošinj, and is the only large-scale bronze statue from this period that has been discovered on the eastern coast of the Adriatic.

Things to do:

Adopt a dolphin and help preserve this protected species and learn about the activities of the Mali Lošinj sea turtle sanctuary.

Climb the hill of Osoršćica and enjoy stunning views of the Lošinj archipelago.

Visit the Garden of Fine Scents and take in the aromatic fragrances of Lošinj.



Island of Krk





Due to its mild Mediterranean climate, favourable geographical position and variety of natural and cultural landmarks, the island of Krk since ancient times has been known as the "Golden Island". Because of its rich Glagolitic heritage, Krk is also regarded as the "cradle of Croatian culture".

Things to see:

The Baška Tablet is a grant dating from the year 1100. This inscribed stone slab with its 13 rows of Glagolitic script is regarded as one of the most precious items of Croatian cultural heritage.

Things to do:

Sample Vrbnička Žlahtina, a quality white wine made from grapes that thrive only on the island of Krk.

Visit the Aquarium in Baška. It has the largest collection of Adriatic mussels and snails in Croatia.

Take a 10-minute boat ride from Punat to the islet of Košljun and its famous Franciscan monastery, a major culturalmuseum site in Croatia, surrounded by a forest vegetation reserve.

Island of Rab





The renaissance island of Rab is known for its scenic diversity and rich forest vegetation. The long bathing season on its wonderful beaches, the magnificent architecture and Romanesque bell towers, the tournament and parade of Rab Crossbowmen – these are just some of the images that you can take back home from this island.

Things to see:

During one of the most famous events in Croatia, the Rabska Fjera summer festival, the entire town of Rab turns into a giant medieval stage with more than 600 of its inhabitants putting on medieval costumes, playing the roles of medieval artisans in anticipation of the magnificent Rab Crossbowmen tournament. The atmosphere of the *Rabska Fjera* is always a particularly memorable experience.

Things to do:

Surrender to the pleasure of Paradise Beach (Rajska Plaža) and enjoy the beauty of other natural coves with wonderful sandy beaches.

Take a bike ride through the shade of the holm oak forest on the Kalifront peninsula.

Climb the hill of Kamenjak and enjoy the spectacular views of the island and the town of Rab, the nearby islands and mighty Mount Velebit.
