high Televrin summit. The narrow land bridge to the Island of Cres is also recognizable there.



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

WHEN I RELOCATED FROM BERLIN TO AUSTRIA, I ALSO ESSENTIALLY MOVED TO KVARNER BAY. IUST A FEW HOURS' DRIVE AWAY. EVERYTHING THERE IS SIGNIFICANTLY MORE RELAXED AND UTTERLY INSPIRING: PEOPLE, ANIMALS AND, ABOVE ALL, THE AIR, WITH ITS AROMAS OF THE SEA AND HERBS.

pon arrival, the world is at once better: the fragrances, colors, sounds – even the sense of time has changed. And so, even before I have moved into my lodgings, my first excursion takes me to Volosko. A drink with a view of small fishing boats at arm's reach, is simply a must. And at this moment, there is nowhere else I would rather be ...

Kvarner Bay, in its own favorable climatic microcosmos between Istria and the Croatian mainland, shows its effects immediately: Either pure energy flows right through me or I find complete peace. With nothing in between. On the one hand, there are the nonchalant harbor activities, the bustle of the markets and the zestful »Bok« (comparable with our »Hello«) in the cafés of the fishing and coastal towns. Honking is still permitted on the roads, flowers form a sea all their own, and even mouse-gray walls are tinged with all shades of patina.

A unique Adriatic garden

On the other, you can find personal retreats almost everywhere, even in the middle of summer: on the coasts beneath laurel trees. bougainvillea, palms and oleander bushes. On the islands between pines, evergreen holly oaks, olive groves and fragrant wild herbs. In the mountainous hinterland surrounded by silence, virtually untouched nature and an immense feeling of freedom.

The nearby karst peaks are home to natural wonders, awaken your yearning for adventure and transform the entire bay into a unique garden park.

Like a mighty defensive wall, the Učka mountains, the Gorski Kotar high plateau and the Velebit massif (from west to east) protect Kvarner Bay from cold air currents. Even subtropical plants thrive here, on the 45th parallel, precisely halfway between North Pole and Equator.

See what the sea can do ...

Nowhere else have I been better able to live up to the maxim »Do nothing but do nothing« than here. Simply breathe in the sensual local perfume: the zest of the sea, the sweetness of acacia and laurel flowers, the aromas of wild herbs concentrated by the

When the urge overcomes me, I jump into the sea in May - partly because the mild temperatures awaken feelings of summer, partly to stick my tongue out at the umbrella still hanging on my door at home. - Yes, happiness is definitely in the air here. Croatia's »dolce vita« is called »lagodan život«, translating as: the light, leisurely, simple life. And indeed, with the sea right before you, you need so much less of everything else.

The Riviera of Opatija – a charming confection of palms

Opatija Riviera, with its parks, turn-of-thecentury villas and beautiful promenade, definitely lives up to its reputation as the »gateway to the Mediterranean world«. Every time I arrive, the views of the Adriatic, the port city of Rijeka as well as the islands of Cres and Krk are very special to me, and the moment the first palm emerges, my entire being switches over to sweet idleness.

»Palm trees just a few minutes' drive from home?«, a friend recently asked me skeptically. Yes, and really hunky ones, not just some dwarf Mediterranean shrubs. These exotic species came here around two hundred years ago, and they came to stay: Seafarers brought them from overseas to give the parks and gardens of their homeland elite flair. The noble spa guests were impressed and became even more inclined to amble through the verdant grounds – not far from Vienna, but so very different (...). To this day, Indian and Californian palms live here in harmony with laurel trees, pines, Mediterranean

WATER & FORESTS

At 1401 meters, the Vojak is the highest summit in Učka Nature Park, while its round stone tower on the Poklon pass affords one of the most beautiful views in Croatia, extending on clear days to the Alps and Italy. The new Visitor Center is also a must-see (p. 16). From the coastal communities of Opatija, Ičići, Ika, Lovran, Medveja and Mošćenička Draga, marked paths lead to your destination. Incidentally: The tap water on the coast originates here and can be consumed without a second thought.



The small villa city of Lovran, with its medieval heart, is named after the nearby forest of laurel trees which ascends to the slopes of the Učka. Here, chestnuts and cherries are celebrated as culinary highlights. Villa San Rocco (photo left), built for Baron Brenner in 1904, was a popular postcard motif 100 years











MARKET FRESH

Velika Placa, the big square and site of the Rijeka city market, is the belly of the region. Here, you will quickly see which inhabitants, vegetables and fruits of the Adriatic are in season and be

able to enjoy them market-fresh at the surrounding konobas. If you allow your mind to journey into the past, you can even walk on water: Until well into the 19th cent., the Adriatic still held sway over the location of today's market; then, the bay was progressively filled in. The beautiful *Jugendstil* fish emporium offers the bounty of the sea quasi right on top of the sea ...

Rijeka – young, cosmopolitan, vibrant, and Cultural Capital 2020

In my case, it was love at second sight, if not the tenth. It took years for me to give this port city, with its communities of high-rises, a chance. It was then that Marija, a *Germanistik* student, stepped into my life, chattering nonstop about »her city«, meaning Rijeka. My initial skepticism led to a very personal city tour and was ultimately transformed into true affection.

If you visit Rijeka with open eyes, you discover a coexistence and intermingling of cultures. A stroll through the lively port quarter surrounding the marketplace is as essential as visiting a café. Constantly encountering colorful murals, sophisticated graffiti art. It is also noteworthy that tourists are able to pedal along forty bike routes, then bathe on several beaches afterwards, never having to leave the city limits. What a pity Rijeka was unable to get the most out of its title »Cultural Capital 2020«. Some things have re-

mained however (p. 20), above all the even more exciting tourism and cultural opportunities.

Gorski Kotar – Bear and lynx in the Wild West

Barely 25 km from Rijeka, on the high plateaus of Gorski Kotar, Grobnicko polje and Platak (*platak.hr*), the biggest Kvarner ski and recreation area, the landscape is so reminiscent of the prairies in classic westerns that numerous scenes from the Winnetou movies were filmed here (1962–1968 and 2014).

This pristine mountain region, with Risn-jak National Park, imposing karst caves and the »Kupa« mountain river, is also a real world of adventure. Rafting, angling, fly fishing, biking, hiking – much is possible in this home of brown bear, wild horses, wolves, lynx, chamois and 178 bird species – including golden eagle.

From Trsat Castle, you enjoy a glorious view of the city, the port and the Rječina river, which empties into the Adriatic 19 km from its source and, in the past, frequently formed the border between different countries.

FROM SHARK TO CAVE BEAR

The Natural History Museum in Rijeka captivates the whole family with exhibits from a shark to a cave bear, plus many aquariums. A permanent exhibition »Wild Animals with Sea View« opened in 2021. Lorenzov prolaz 1, Rijeka, prirodoslovni.com

RISNJAK NATIONAL PARK

Declared a National Park in 1957, this natural connection between the Alps and Dinarides, including the 1528 m summit of »Veliki Risnjak«, has beautiful prospects in store for visitors <u>np-risnjak.hr</u>. Also running through it: 2 long-distance hiking paths, the »Via Dinarica« <u>viadinarica</u>. <u>com/de</u> and »Via Adriatica« <u>viaadriatica.org</u>.

THE 3 BIG PREDATORS

In the historic small village of Stara Sušica, with its Frankopan castle, a visitor center was recently opened. It is impossible to imagine a better location than here in the middle of Gorski Kotar. »Velike zvijeri« (»Big Predators«) casts a spotlight on the local forest dwellers: bears, wolves and lynx. centar-velikezvijeri.eu

BEAR WATCHING

A recipe for adventure: Take one guide with Jeep, a wood cabin in the forest to overnight, an observation station and night-vision equipment... and a bear (at least one) will come. crobear.eu



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HIDEAWAY

Translated, this Croatian saying basically means »Green, I love you so much«. The protection and preservation of nature is important to the residents of Kvarner bay, since they were bestowed with »Green« in abundance: The island archipelago of Cres/Lošinj alone boasts 1500 different plant species on just 405 km². In comparison: On the much bigger island of Great Britain (ca. 220,000 km²), only 1200 have been counted.

BELI VISITOR CENTER CRES

The decline of the once far larger sheep population on the island resulted in the majestic griffon vultures disappearing from the region almost completely. This eco- and rescue center for injured animals is dedicated to them. In an interactive exhibition, visitors also learn interesting facts about flora, fauna and island life. belivisitorcentre.eu

EXPLORE RAB VIA APP



Big and small hobby archaeologists (also »real« ones) can now explore the island of Rab interactively by means of an app. With virtual storytellers,

audio tours, augmented reality and exciting puzzles, discovering 30 archaeological sites is fun for the whole family. The app also functions offline.

CAMINO KRK PILGRIMAGE WAY

Part of the European Way of St. James (Spanish: »Camino de Santiago«), this pilgrimage path leads from the cathedral in the city of Krk via 150 km, mountain summits with fantastic views, four Franciscan monasteries and bays reminiscent of the south seas, through the extraordinary natural beauty of the island.

THE DOLPHINS OF LOŠINJ

The Blue World Institute <u>blue-world.</u>
<u>org</u> cares for and researches native dolphins in the nature sanctuary off the coast of Lošinj island, providing interesting insights into the lifestyle and development of these roughly 200 animals. The ca. 20 km long "Dolphin Path", leading hikers from sunny Borik bay to Krivica bay, features numerous dolphin-watching opportunities. <u>visitlosinj.hr/de/der-weg-der-delphine.aspx</u>



Earlier, Cres and Lošinj were a single island and, due to their proximity to the Amber Road, important for trade by sea. Around 2000 years ago, the Romans separated the two islands at the town of Osor by means of a manmade canal, thereby cutting distances for smaller ships. Osor, the main town of both islands for centuries, can be explored like a museum. The music evenings (July/August) are a highlight for Classical fans: osorfestival.eu.

Krk Island - one for all

Since 1980, the island of Krk has been connected to the mainland via a 1430 m long bridge, representing a significant tourism advantage. The result is astounding: Effervescent resort towns with family-friendly beaches and virtually every opportunity for watersports, hand-in-hand with a wealth of marvelously preserved culture treasures, hiking and biking routes, a pilgrimage way and a wine that is unique worldwide, the Žhlatina.

When I explored the island for the first time in my own way, going by instinct, following narrow side roads and pathways, I was amazed by the size of the forest I drove through for quite some time. Until then, I had been more aware of the elephant-skin-like east side of the island which faces the coast road on the Croatian mainland - swept bare and left barren by the Bora winds. Suddenly and quite unexpectedly, »a clearing full of wine« ended my forest excursion. A large, completely protected expanse of grapevines revealed itself; easily 100 ha in size! That said, the nearby wine town of Vrbnik, enthroned on a hilltop, is not only known for its Old Town, but also an epicurean mecca for vinophiles, with konobas, restaurants and bars. With beautiful sea access to boot.

In the past, most of the island populace grew fruit and vegetables, supplying their products to the mainland coast. The current »farm-to-table« project of the Toljanić winegrowing family is an extension of that – with a more current interpretation (p. 36).

Cres Island - wild, captivating beauty

If you love nature, you will immediately take Cres to your heart. Much here is as it was decades ago, tourism is gentle, life not easy for young people, but for older types, such as myself, idyllic: the practically primeval Tramontana forest in the north, the meager stone-strewn meadows, the griffon vultures which circle majestically overhead, nesting on steep cliffs above the sea close to the medieval town Beli, the intermittently almost bewitching fragrance of wild herbs, original hiking paths, hidden bays and, naturally, the sheep which, from time to time, take a nap in the middle of the road. The island belongs to them after all.

A natural wonder indeed: the Blue Grotto in Žanje bay. It can be reached (tip: in late autumn) only by boat or on foot; the last few meters must be swum. When the sun casts its beams through the opening in the grotto – ethereally beautiful!

Lošinj Island – aroma therapy & dolphins

My girlfriend, an asthma sufferer, spends three weeks every year on the island of Lošinj, preferably in October/November. The reason is as simple as it is impressive: From the moment she steps onto the island, she gets incrementally better. The microclimate of the island, saturated with tiny micro-aerosols, and the essential oils of an incredible 230 species of healing plants make her inhaler dispensable, even though she takes hikes almost daily.


Actually, this isn't new news: Losinj was declared a health destination in 1892 and in »Yugoslavia times« provided therapy to children from the GDR coping with asthma and neurodermatitis. Making it even more astonishing that even regular guests often don't know about these health benefits. They

simply feel good, whether on the campground or in a luxury hotel. The native dolphin population in the south of the island (some 200 animals) also appears to appreciate the quality of life here.

Rab – an island paradise

If you believe the tradition, the ancient Romans would party for days on end. That was likely also the case in Rab, the home port for one of their biggest fleets. Also traditional with young visitors: "partying" on select island beaches (Pudarica, Barbat) and at bars and clubs surrounded by centuries-old walls.

But Rab wouldn't be a Kvarner island if it didn't unite parallel worlds: Families love the natural sand beaches that transition gently into the sea, the campgrounds and the hospitable private hosts. Active holidaymakers find countless sporting ways to discover the multifaceted natural landscapes. And for fans of the Middle Ages, the annual »Rabska Fijera« summer festival is almost a duty: For two full weeks, Rab celebrates its history. And the backdrop couldn't be more authentic: four prominent belltowers clad in medieval walls, meandering cobbled lanes and narrow stairways, monasteries, churches and stone palaces.

Our Adriatic In contrast to billions of years of Earth history, the Adriatic is still in its infancy. Only 12,000 years ago, when the glaciers of the last Ice Age melted, was the basin of today's Adriatic deluged by the Mediterranean. The karst mountain landscapes that had once risen from the sea, were transformed again into a maritime world of islands and islets, with summits and ridges that continued to touch the skies above. Almost enclosed, the Adriatic warms only slowly, but retains pleasant bathing temperatures until well into October. And for many

Europeans, so close to home!

Sandy and fine-gravel beaches extending flat into the Adriatic make the rivieras of Crikvenica and Novi Vinodolski popular holiday classics for families. As a small child, my neighbor's daughter was able to say »Crikvenica« (pronounced »Tsrikvenitza«) before she could say »holidays«. Not kidding! They also do a lot there to ensure big and small feel right at home: On the official beaches, you will find all forms of water sport, ice cream parlors, restaurants and cafés. Making it easy for grown-ups to be lazy, beaming the kids up to holiday heaven. Also inviting: the seaside promenades lined by palms and pine trees.

Because no one likes leaving their pet at home, dogs are welcome at many places. There is a dog hotel, along with several beaches for quadrupeds and their companions. »Monty's Dog Beach & Bar«, close to the Podvorska harbor in Crikvenica, claims to be the most beautiful dog beach in Croatia (monty.hr).

Regardless of where you find yourself on the Kvarner mainland coast: Krk island can always be seen on the horizon. Needless to say, you can ferry across from the ports

DONKEY RIDES

Once the most important helper of Kvarner farmers, the donkeys of today deserve being taken care of, fed well and stroked. On the donkey farm in the small village of Šmrika (photo) run by Suzi Lucić together with her children Iva Mari, Marko and Mihael, the program includes donkey rides for children, rides on a three-wheeled carriage and walks with the donkeys to a small cave and a scenic spot with sensational views of the bay and bridge between Krk and the mainland.

Breathe healthily and conquer castles

The port cities of Crikvenica and Novi Vinodolski and the smaller towns of Selce, Dramalj and Jadranovo have one thing in common – the healthful climate. Here, too, there is a long tradition of health tourism, offers ranging from therapy for infant children (thalasso-ck.hr) to ultra-professional sportsmedicine services at »Terme Selce«, where more than 120 Olympic champions have been able to recuperate (terme-selce.hr). So many things can be integrated into a bathing holiday, such as inpatient therapy or »Mama's own personal timeout« at the day spa.

Of course, the mainland coast wouldn't be a typical Kvarner region if it didn't also feature a green hinterland welcoming nature lovers, culture fans and active vacationers in total silence: with the fertile »Vinodol« wine valley, the ancient Velebit mountains, beautiful biking & hiking paths, carp-filled Tribalj lake, and the castles, churches and monasteries of the noble Frankopan family (p. 22/23).

For more than 170 years, up to 3 m tall camellia bushes have adorned the parks of Opatija. This tea plant, imported from the Far East by seafarers, is one of the first plants to bud in December. Also known as the winter rose, it blooms and is fragrant until early May.



Fly with the bats, use a kinetic table to explore the mountain, immerse yourself in the home of bears and golden eagles, 70 bird and 263 butterfly species, and get to know the bellflower »Campanula tommasiniana«, unique worldwide. – The Poklon Visitor Center in Učka Nature Park at 930 meters opened its doors in May 2021.

Interactive exhibitions convey a whole new feeling for the mountainous climes of Učka and Ćićarija, intended to sharpen awareness for the environment, especially the valuable world of plants and animals. The numerous recreation opportunities in the mountains are also presented: hiking, self-guided theme paths, cycling, mountain biking, free climbing, paragliding (...). There is a café, a playground, and a souvenir shop with original works by local artists, nice memorabilia, and items for fans of nature and hiking.

7 guestions for THE CAMELLIA EXPERT

A passionate camellia grower, horticulturist Katica Dražić held leading positions in the municipal gardens of Opatija for 21 years and has overseen the garden parks of a private hotel group since 2018.

What is so special about this »newcomer«, the camellia, that it became the emblem of Opatija?

The camellia originates in mild regions of China, where it prefers semi-shade and acidic soil. There are 280 different species there; including »Camellia sinensis«, which we know as green tea. So, the camellia is quite exotic, but it found a new home in the climate of Opatija Riviera. Though it is also loved for its local story.

What story is that?

The first camellia was planted by wealthy businessman Iginio Scarpa upon the early death of his wife Angiolina, which rapidly resulted in a kind of »camellia boom«. Not least because the flowers of this plant brought added life to the then winter

spa resort of Abbazia, precisely at the time when Europe's nobility were residing there.

How many species of camellia grow on the Riviera of Opatija?

You will find three species of camellia, primarily the »Camellia japonica«, but also »Camellia sasanqua« and »Camellia reticulata«. In public areas of Opatija, there are about 200 bushes or small camellia trees with flowers of many different colors: red, pink, white, and more rarely yellow or purple.

Do all species bloom at the same time?

No, which is really nice: The »Camellia japonica«, which has become the emblem of Opatija, often develops buds in December and blooms until the beginning of May. In October, the »Camellia sasanqua« is in its full glory.



MALI LOŠINJ GARDEN OF AROMAS

The herb garden of Sandra Nicholich, which she planted by hand on 3500 m² of land, has become an institution in Mali Lošinj. A paradise full of scents, with donkeys, and a shop where you can find useful and beautiful items, such as herbal sea salt, homemade liqueurs, fragrance pouches, herbal teas, spices and skincare products.



pen-air art, such as large-scale murals (graffiti) and installations as well as sculptures by contemporary artists, on the mainland and island coasts (project »Lungomare Art«), were indeed possible in the pandemic-constrained cultural capital Rijeka and continue to enhance its public spaces. Though in the long term, the legacy for this bustling port city and its visitors will be far greater still.

Culture manager Irena Kregar Šegota confirmed that RIJEKA 2020 represented »the biggest investment in Croatian culture since 1945«, with the restoration and transformation of the Benčić industrial complex, which had been abandoned for many years, indisputably the most valuable legacy of the city's title. Amongst other things, it is now home to the City Museum in the former sugar factory, a cradle of progress back in the 19th cent. The old tobacco factory now houses the Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art – a vibrant, variety-rich, family-friendly

questions for Velid Đekić, author of several books about Rijeka's industrial, musical and urban history, also Publicity Director for the City Museum.

The new City Museum is very popular with locals. What makes it interesting for tourists?

The biggest baroque palace of commerce in the Habsburg monarchy, with its imposing interior, visually impressive main staircase, the freshly restored wall veduta and the beautiful reliefs of the vaulted ceilings, is impressive in its own right. The former headquarters of the sugar factory, it represents the industrialization of the city, in a positive sense, since it was because of this complex that Rijeka developed in the 19th cent. from a harbor town of just 4000 residents into a modern, vibrant metropolis. An exciting history that can be discovered in the form of 30 themes in 30 rooms.

Which of these rooms is your personal favorite?

A small room on the 2nd floor displaying the only living being (small photo above). At first glance, the depiction of a man's head on the main façade purports to dominate the room and guests. An illusion, since it is the sugarcane opposite which is the actual star of the room, of the entire museum. Without it, this palace would not be here. The museum crew tends to the plant with almost loving devotion.

There are multiple ways to interpret Rijeka's invention of the torpedo. How do you see it?

Born in Rijeka, Giovanni Luppis invented the torpedo in 1860 to protect his homeland against attacks from the sea. He christened it the »Coast Saver«. Can you hold that against him? For me, it attests to the fantastic power of human creativity, which has many faces. And without the technological solutions given to us by torpedoes, space travel and submarines simply wouldn't be possible. The bow thruster and autopilot used on ships are »peaceful side effects« of the torpedo's invention.



Where it all began

Villa Angiolina in Opatija marks the beginning of tourism throughout the country, making it the ideal location for the CROATIAN TOURISM MUSEUM. Personal photos, utensils and stories provide intriguing insights into a time which many still remember. hrmt.hr

ow only ruins, yet the former Gradec Castle near the small town of Vrbnik on Krk island emanates a fascinating aura. With a little imagination, you can envision how Count Dujam I, the first patriarch of the Frankopans, resided here over 900 years ago with his wife Marija. In the year 1118, he entered into a contract with mighty Venice, granting him Krk as his principality.



To achieve that, he had doubtlessly been very resourceful. Making his lack of imagination when it came to naming his sons even more puzzling:Bartol I and Bartol II. Though the third of the brothers was called Vid. If the three of them were fond of swimming, Gradec Castle was ideal. The nearby beaches and beautiful bays of Melska, Sv. Marak and Supovica are as rewarding now as then. And something else not to overlook:the winegrowing town of Vrbnik. Amid its maze of winding thoroughfares, »Klančić« is officially

the narrowest street in Croatia, just forty centimeters wide! Sucking in your tummy is highly recommended ...

The Routes of the Frankopans

»The Routes of the Frankopans« is a new tourist attraction encompassing 17 forts and three sacred buildings. Each tells its own story about the life of this noble family, about love and passion, conspiracies and intrigues, faith and power. From the beginning of the 12th century until the second half of the 17th, the Frankopans – as lawgivers, warriors and politicians, though also poets, sketch artists and painters – shaped Croatian history and

The colossal stone walls of the Frankopan fortifications, with four city gates and defensive towers, frame the historic city center of Krk. Built between the 12th and 15th centuries a veritable monument to the power and stature of this dynasty. A must-see: the former belltower houses an exhibition documenting the colorful history of the descendants of Dujam I.

Whilst Krk is the cradle of this noble family, the Routes of the Frankopans lead to other highlights of the Kvarner Region: to a splendidly rugged coast of countless small bays, to idyllic beaches. And onwards, to a lush green hinterland of virtually virgin nature, wild rivers and silent lakes, endless expanses of beech trees, pine forests and majestic mountains.



Sweet Legacy

The Frankopan Cake undoubtedly conceals one or two excess calories. In one of the first cookbooks to appear in Central Europe, dated 1686, the baking instructions are described in opulent Baroque detail.

The recipe collection was authored by Countess Eleonore Marie Rosalie von Eggenberg. To this day, the Frankopan Cake is still prepared by the patisserie of Hotel International Crikvenica true to the original recipe. The classic ingredients: filo pastry, cinnamon, almonds and rum-soaked raisins. After bathing at one of the family-friendly city beaches and with a view of the picturesque small harbor, it tastes twice as good.



ELIZABETA FRANKOPAN

This was certainly not a love match:at just two years of age, Elizabeta was betrothed to the then 24-year-old Count Fridrik II of Celje, an influential nobleman of the Hungarian and Croatian Crown, of Styria and the German Empire. From 1414 to 1422, she lived separated from her husband. An attempted reconciliation with him ended tragically for her – with a hunting knife

On the Love Path

An example worth seeing of a Frankopan sacred building is the Pauline monastery in Crikvenica. The early 15th century church of the monastery, endowed by Count Nikola Frankopan IV, also lent its name to the city. Due to their white habits, the Paulines, whose order endured until 1786, were known

as the »white monks«. Today, the building, right next to the water, is home to a hotel. Sloping gently down to the sea, the beach of Crikvenica is especially popular among families with children, while ten »Kissing Spots« along the 8 km »Love Path« represent quite a temptation. The nearby wine town of Novi Vinodolski, with its dreamy historic quarter, is also romantic, though active holidaymakers will also be blissfully happy; on the »Blue Bike Path«, leading through the small villages of Bribir, Tribalj and Drivenik (38 km).

Flowers in the Devil's Garden

The ancient Romans didn't fill their minds with romantic thoughts about nature. They declared the mountainous countryside of Gorski Kotar, with its dense forests, impassible, a land that only the devil might enter, »Hortus Diabolicus«, Gorski Kotar. the Devil's Garden.

In contrast, the Frankopans and their noble relatives, the Zrinski family, were well able to exploit the treasures of this wilderness. They built roads, iron-smelting huts, sawand grain mills, and established commerce.

Lying on the ROUTES OF THE FRANKOPANS are Zrinski Castle in Čabar and Stara Sušica Castle in the town of the same name. Today, in the immediate vicinity of the Stara Sušica Castle there is a »Large Carnivores« Visitor Centre which houses an exhibition about the three big animals of prey native to

NOBLE GENEROSITY


If you believe the legend, the Frankopans were named after two brothers from an ancient Roman family who handed out bread on the market square to the hungry. The name Frangipan, later Frankopan, is supposedly derived from the Latin »frangere panem« - to tear bread. One of the brothers ended up on the Island of Krk.



of the small fortification of Rovoznik (today's Gradec) on Krk became the founder of one of the oldest and most powerful Croatian noble families, will likely always remain a mystery. It appears that the Venetians who ruled on the island at that time deliberately named a local as count to assure local stability and more easily protect their own interests.





or local gastronomes and journalists, it represents a highly cherished déjàvu: Cooks from other countries regularly rave about the high-quality foods in Kvarner Bay: »What we once had to order from a gourmet food supplier, we now have essentially right outside our own front door« – this is the credo of today. And indeed, the region can rejoice in an intact environment with high biodiversity – bringing pure pleasure to the plate!

Here, we present to you three families of regional products, whose uniqueness has been further confirmed by an EU Protected Designation of Origin. Certain to be followed by many more.

Winged conservationist with a proboscis

For bees, Kvarner Bay is a paradise. Anyone following current discussions about their endangered existence is aware that, besides producing honey, they also pollenate around 75% of all European wildflowers and cultivated plants. In short: These busy collectors secure a large part of our food supply, including roughly 4000 types of fruits and vegetables. Without bees, we wouldn't have many building materials, barely any natural remedies, the list is long. One more reason to treasure the wide variety of high-quality honey that is produced and offered along the coast, on the islands and in the mountains.

Unique and healthy: honeydew

Talking of mountains, in 2021, Gorski Kotar was able to earn a PDO for its »Medun«. This wild honey does not consist of flower nectar, but rather honeydew, a kind of tree juice requiring suitable conditions, meaning it is not produced every year and is quite rare. »Medun is by far the healthiest way to revitalize the body«, states beekeeper Branko Vidmar, also known in his home region as »the father of Medun«, explaining why locals have valued their wild honey as a home remedy for centuries: »It contains twelve times more minerals than nectar honey and is especially rich in folic acid.«







Written records show that Medun was already produced in the Gorski Kotar region back in the 13th cent. Spicier and less sweet than flower honey, this specialty is also excellent for cooking. With a little bit of luck, on the menu at Hotel Bitoraj in Fužine you might well find a dish labeled »Kare veprića s goranskim medunom«: rack of wild boar marinated in spruce needles and Medun, prepared like roast beef and served with grated potatoes, pureed parsley root, homemade yogurt and honey-mustard sauce.

Olive oil from unique varieties

Thanks to extensive revitalization efforts over the past 20 years, Croatia's olive oils are today amongst the world's best. Whilst the time of harvest and modern production methods mainly determine the quality of the oil, it is the olive varieties that are pressed which impact the flavor. »Ekstra djevičansko maslinovo ulje Cres« – Croatia's premier olive oil with »PDO« designation since 2015 comes from the Island of Cres and is pressed exclusively from the indigenous varieties »Slivniača« and »Plominka«. The fruits must be grown, collected, stored and processed on the island. One year later, the »liquid gold« from the Island of Krk also received well-deserved certification, made unique through use of native olive varieties »Debela«, »Naška«, »Rošulja« and »Slatka«. As different as the flavor of these two island oils may be – their common denominator is their luminescent color along with aromas of green fruits and herbs.

Pršut – the synonym for comfort food

Also when it comes to the full-flavored ham Pršut, originality protections make abundant sense, not least because this pork leg of ham is created differently throughout the country: in Dalmatia, smoked in the skin, in Istria, airdried with the pelvic bone, but without the skin, on the Island of Krk, also without smoke, though also without the pelvic bone, and with the skin. Similarly, the spice mix with sea salt and herbs is different everywhere. Since 2015, »Krčki pršut« is the first Croatian product to carry the »PGI« label – a pioneering achievement of the Žužić family who, in the capital of the island, run the »House of Krk Pršut« including a tavern and butcher's shop. How nice that the Toljanić family from Vrbnik has likewise become involved in Pršut production, also raising their own pigs (p.36).



ALWAYS A HARVEST

Throughout the year, local specialties are celebrated within the framework of high-spirited folk festivals, with all visitors welcome. Each in their own season, wild asparagus, strawberries, cherries, olives and chestnuts enrich the menus of cafés and restaurants with mouthwatering dishes. Events calendar: kvarner.hr

A GREAT PLACE TO LIVE

Clearly, Kvarner scampi have been fortunate to find ideal living conditions in Kvarner Bay, attested to by the fact that »culinary circles« view the species living there as amongst the European crustacean elite. The »blue mud« on the sea floor and the local nutrition sources allow this solitary creature, a bottom-dweller living in small cavities, to develop its very fine flavor. Gourmets describe its flesh as particularly tender, praising its spicy-nutty aroma, gentle sweetness and elegant note of marzipan. In contrast to other members of its species which are forced to survive in the colder and generally significantly deeper waters of the far north, the shell of the Kvarner population is lighter and thinner – yet another distinguishing characteristic.

SCAMPI OR PRAWN?

THE SMALL BIG DIFFERENCE

As with all precious things, Kvarner scampi is not safe from counterfeits, not least because, when cooked, the significantly cheaper flesh of prawns looks very similar. Unlike scampi, prawns are farmed internationally, varying significantly in quality, taste and price.

runo's handshake says a lot about the man at the other end of the arm, or more precisely: his challenging profession. Scampi fisherman – a back-breaking job if you have to live from it, and if you also catch these sea creatures in an eco-friendly way with baskets, rather than higher-yielding trawling nets.

»Trawlers plow the seafloor flat, along with everything that lives and grows there«, explains the fisherman. We agree that the significantly stricter Croatian fishing regulations of recent years make sense. You can no longer fish wherever you want, every boat can be located by GPS, there are stringently controlled off-seasons for many species, while the planned and actual catches must be reported.

Virtually empty baskets ... better not to ask.

At 5 AM, we cast off in Bruno's small boat. It was a full moon overnight. »That's when the »Šcampi« (pronounced »Shkampi«) are heavier and their flesh is juicier«, he points out eagerly. He responds to my guestion »Why« with a shrug of the shoulders: »Simply how it

Soon, we have reached the first of ten buoys in his fishing area. Suspended from it is a long line with 30 rectangular scampi baskets, 300 in total. The winch attached to the boat squeaks as Bruno, with a practiced hand, hoists one basket after another out of the water, enthusiastically removing his live catch, directing it into a bucket and replacing the

bait in the middle of the basket. Finally, he allows the long line to glide back out into the depths of the Adriatic. I am troubled. As a rule, there are only one, two scampi per basket, rarely three, often none. Can that be normal? Better not to ask, even if Bruno's expression shows no signs of annoyance or disappointment.

It is afternoon. While the autopilot navigates us back to port, the fisherman sorts the big crustaceans into basins, where they seemingly move about in slow motion. Two restaurants will shortly be delighted by the delivery, and especially Bruno's son, who is the head chef and owner of a popular gourmet restau-

»Most basket fishermen (incidentally: around 40 in all of Kvarner Bay) sell their catch to local restaurants«, he tells me. That is good, very good, since it means a higher profit margin for them and is kinder on the wallet of people, like me, who simply love scampi. Marinated raw, on the grill, in pasta, risotto, or prepared traditionally Ȉ la Buzara«: with a little garlic, rosemary, breadcrumbs, a shot of white wine as well as pepper and salt, cooked in its own juices (...).

Quality, not quantity. That was a super catch!

Basket fishermen always deliver first-rate quality: Exclusively big, extremely clean animals that were not fished out of the mud. but rather swam into the basket in the course of their nightly foray for food. Aside from allowing young animals to escape and, thus, the species to thrive, this sustainable method of catching also prevents the animals being crushed or injured, making it possible for them to be delivered live to the

»The best restaurants and konobas, in particular, appreciate the top-quality product«, says Bruno, weighing the scampi. Only now do I find the courage to ask: »Are the baskets always so empty?« Which provokes a laugh from the fisherman: »I was waiting for that question. Six kilos! – Today was a super catch. Time for a biska?« – You bet!

His sensitively created plates captivate every bit as much as the views from the 5th floor. The fact that NEBO translates to »heaven« is underscored in multiple

A beautiful gastronomic story

When we visited Deni at the »Draga di Lovrana« in 2019, the young man had just taken over from two-toque chef Zdravko Tomšić, the pioneer of Kvarner gourmet cuisine, and was being celebrated as a shooting star due

to his Michelin star. Modestly, he questioned whether this meant he was actually the better cook: »I learned an incredible amount from Zdravko«, showing his mentor due respect. – Rightly so: After his celebrated »student« moved to the Hilton, Zdravko again took over the reins, likewise cooking up a Michelin star at the »Draga di Lovrana«! In doing so, he remained true to his more puristic style.

Star above Čikat Bav

Some might be rather surprised that the restaurant of 5-star Boutique Hotel Alhambra on the Island of Lošinj bears the name ALFRED KELLER. – It is actually a hommage to the Viennese architect who envisioned this historic building. The irony of destiny: Since 2021, this place has again been shaped by an Austrian. 26-year-old Upper Austrian Michael Gollenz runs the ALFRED KELLER for Swiss 2-star chef Christian Kuchler and successfully rustled up the first Michelin star for Kvarner Island.

Excited by the quality of regional products, he refined the Mediterranean cuisine of this establishment with his own very personal signature, French nuances and gently employed Asiatic aromas.

In Kvarner Bay, Opatija, Rijeka, Vinodol, Krk, Rab and Cres-Lošinj form the third-largest Croatian winegrowing area. 2 million liters of wine are produced here annually, with three-quarters of the 200 ha total cultivated area planted with the indigenous Žlahtina grape. A distinction of quality coupled with traditional values and hospitality, in addition to KVARNER GOURMET and KVARNER FOOD, as of recently KVARNER WINES also serves as a guideline for gourmets. >

Wine Festivals

Under the patronage of winegrowing icon Ivica Dobrinčić (Šipun winery), the winegrowers reorganized, intensifying their collaborative campaigns and presentations. In addition to numerous wine festivals throughout the bay area, the whole regional wine scene also gathers every year in June for the »WineRi Festival« in Rijeka. In addition to the Žlahtina grape variety, you will find other native rarities here, such as the protected-origin white wine cuvée Belica from Kastav and red wines Sansigot, Brajdica and Trojišćina. Local farmers and producers likewise present their own products.

resh air and Adriatic feeling to the max: Stand-up paddling, a.k.a. SUP, is the absolute hit in Kvarner Bay right now.

Nowadays, there isn't a single island or riviera that doesn't offer SUP rentals and courses. The port city of Rijeka also boasts two absolute SUP hotspots on the beaches of Kostrena and Kantrida. On the islands, too, stand-up paddlers are in seventh heaven. If you keep your ears open, you will quickly learn what makes this activity so attractive to all age groups: Once you have caught your balance on the board, you have an incompa-



rable way to explore the coastal beauty at

A far more challenging variant is SUP yoga. As you train on the unstable water surface, your body tension is taken to a whole new level, penetrating into the deepest muscle groups. SUP yoga is offered by the SUNBIRD windsurfing school (www.sunbird. de) on Losinj and the Marotti Windsurfing Center in Volosko (marottiwindsurfing.hr/ sup), to name but two.

Incidentally: If you prefer the freshwater, use your SUP to explore Bajer or Lokvarsko lakes surrounded by the pristine mountain landscapes of Gorski Kotar.

NEW! Croatia's first SUP club was founded in April 2021 in Volosko near Opatija. The SUP regattas organized by the club for children and adults enjoy a large international turnout. facebook.com/vopsupteam




THE PRIVILEGE OF DIVERS

In shallow reefs overgrown with gorgonia, discover seahorses and octopuses. Search the rocks for lobsters and well camouflaged scorpionfish. Dive down to the ghostly shipwrecks on the seafloor of once-busy trade routes, where scampi, conger eels, spider crabs and small lobsters now make their home. Under the water, Kvarner Bay reveals an exhilarating parallel world.









FIY **ABOVE THE WATER**

There are many opportunities for windsurfing in Kvarner Bay, also at unique locations such as Preluk Bay near Volosko – a surfing hotspot where the Tramontana wind blows in the morning at least 200 days out

of the year. Reason enough for world champion Enrico Marotti to open his Windsurf Center there, where you can learn the basics of the sport, also stand-up paddling. Rental equipment is available, as is a rescue boat. A brand-new offer: E-foil surfing, letting you essentially »fly« above the water surface (photo).

HIKING

More than 300 hiking paths crisscross the variety-rich natural landscapes of Kvarner Bay. Lots of information and maps are available online and from local tourist offices.

NORDIC WALKING & JOGGING

Numerous promenades right by the sea and beautiful forest paths allow joggers and Nordic walkers to exercise in the healthy fresh air. Many hotels offer Nordic-walking poles to borrow and auided tours.

ADRENALINE KICKS

Wakeboarding, rafting, skydiving, paragliding, climbing, ziplining high above the sea, or putting the pedal to the metal on the former Grobnik Grand Prix racetrack (near Rijeka) – if you love adventure, you won't have to look for long.

Within a few kilometers, the natural landscapes of the southernmost Kvarner island are constantly transformed: sandy beaches, rocky crags, barren steppes, lush green meadows. Millennia-old artefacts and excavations, such as a ceramic oven used by the Romans, attest to the long settlement of this island. In 2021, three interactive theme paths spanning 40 km, leading to 30 archaeological sites, were signposted to create an outdoor museum of archaeology. Info boards and an app (with offline functionality) with virtual storytellers, augmented reality, games and exciting puzzles, also involve younger explorers. 
