

Betina was built on the slopes of cape Artić. The town is overlooked by the Baroque bell tower of the church of St. Francis which opens up onto a web of small stone alleys typical of Mediterranean architecture. Due to the unparalleled beauty of the preserved historical centre, which is under the protection of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Croatia, Betina is rightly known as the "pearl of the Adriatic".

The people of Betina are renowned expert caulkers-ship-builders who make ships out of wood, which has been a long tradition preserved until this day. Our most famous shipbuilding product is the wooden boat gajeta of Betina. The art of building the

Betina gajeta is protected as a cultural good of the Republic of Croatia, as is the Betina gajeta Cicibela - an example of the original type of gajeta which used to be built in Betina. The Betina Museum of Wooden Shipbuilding contains a rich ethnological and shipbuilding collection, while the information centre of the National Park Kornati and Nature Park Vransko jezero (Lake Vrana) will introduce you to the natural wonders of these parks located in the immediate vicinity of Betina. Apart from beautiful beaches, Betina also offers camping sites, private apartments, restaurants and cafés. There is also the Marina Betina, a place for various sailing and other activities.

















Town of Drniš is centre of region extending from the southern slopes of Promina mountain, across Petrovo field to the river Čikola and Moseć mountain and Miljevci plateau to Krka river canyon.

This area has been inhabited since prehistoric times, later becaming bordering area between Ilyrian tribes. Here was Liburnian town of Promona, later taken over by Delmatae. who turned it to become the point of resistance to Rome, until Octavian conquered it 33 BC. Later Promina mountain was named after it.

First document mentioning name of Drniš dates from 1494. Later town was governed

by Ottoman Empire, Venetian Republic and Habsburg Monarchy. Remains of architectural monuments, especially Ottomans, still withnes those days.

Some of the most beautiful parts of Krka National Park are located in Drniš area. It is also well known for its prosciutto, wines and traditional and cultural heritage. Town is known for its sacral buildings and medieval fortifications Gradina and nearby Ključica. This is homeland of word famous sculptor Ivan Meštrović and many of his art works can be seen here. People of this area proudly nurture music and folk traditions, inwrought in many cultural events.

Jezera, the town of seafarers, fishermen and divers is located on the southeast side of the island of Murter. The first written data about Jezera date back to the year 1298. The name Jezera comes from the fact that rain is stopped by the impermeable ground, making large puddles. Around Jezera there are numerous roads and paths through olive groves, pine forests and dense bushes which make it ideal for walks and bicycle riding on all sides of the island. The tradition of cultural gatherings of the inhabitants of Jezera is continued today by the folklore society KUD «Koledišće» which was founded in 1970. In the last week of September, this association organizes an international competition called «Big game fishing -Jezera». The Tradition of old skills is kept by the Association Južnje strane (South side). This association is known for its wooden sailboat regatta Jezerska lantina. Along with the traditional annual feasts/ festivals for public and religious holidays (Christmas and new year fair, fancy carnival, Holy week, Sailor Ball of Jezera, the anniversary of the restoration of the St. Nicholas Church, Corpus Christi, Nativity of the Virgin Mary) during the summer months they organize Jezera's Days of the Sea.

Every year the ACI Marina in Jezera receives an international blue flag for environmental preservation.














A city whose history can be found on every corner, with numerous places to relax and learn something new, as well as make lifetime memories.

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





The town of Murter is located in the western part of the island of Murter and dates back to prehistory. The Roman settlement of Colentum lies at the foot of the hill Gradina and can be visited and enjoyed alongside the numerous promenades, viewpoints and beaches, and an underwater archaeological site. For a more urban setting, visit the ideal pebble beach Luke. The Slanica cove contains several camping and glamping sites, surrounded by centuries-old olive groves. The turquoise sandy beaches of Slanica, Podvrške and Čigrađa are favourite spots for family tourism. Murter comprises administratively of approximately 170 islands of the Kornati archipelago which was declared a national park in 1980.



Ancient Scardona, built about 6.000 years ago is romantic small town where the river Krka meets the Adriatic Sea.

Skradin is a city with narrow tiled streets, alleys, arches and stairs while the whole old town core is a protected cultural monument.

Square of Blessed Virgin is surrounded by the city government building, rectory and the church of Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. One of Skradin's main places of interest is kampanel (bell tower), not raised as usually by the church Nativity of Mary. Medieval fortress of the governor Paul Šubić of Bribir, also called Turina was built during the reign of the governor Paul Šubić at the site of the old Liburnian ruins. One of the most spectacular views spreads all the way from the bay Rokovača, the ACI marina till the new bridge built on the highway nearby the restaurant and belvedere Krka.

Skradin is simply magical in his every detail. This magic is reflected in domestic and traditional food, which contains the culinary influences from his attackers and invaders - Romans, French, Austrians, Venetians. Turks.










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




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Šibenik - the oldest Croatian city on the Adriatic coast and the centre of the Šibenik tourist region. Unlike other cities on the Adriatic coast, which originated in antiquity, Šibenik was founded by the Croats after the great movement of the peoples at the end of the 9<sup>th</sup> or beginning of the 10<sup>th</sup> century.

Its name was mentioned for the first time in 1066, and it has enjoyed the status of a city and diocesan seat since 1298.

Despite the fact that it has been destroyed many times from the 12<sup>th</sup> until the middle of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, and that from the middle

of the 14<sup>th</sup> until the end of the 20<sup>th</sup> century it has been almost continously under foreign rule, it has managed to preserve its rich historical heritage and the authentic Croatian identity.

The old city of Šibenik is one of the largest and best preserved authentic mediaeval towns. Its historical core started to develop at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> and the beginning of the 15<sup>th</sup> century and has become part of the St. James cathedral, a protected area, which since 2000 is under the patronage of UNESCO as a part of the world cultural and historical heritage.









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Tisno is a miniature large town. A village with an urban feel, with beautiful stone houses, churches, historical and cultural sights, hidden beaches behind every corner, taverns, pizzerias, restaurants and pastry shops. It has its own style and way of life supported by cultural institutions and social events throughout the year. The central venues for socialising are charming local cafés, each with their own unique story, tasty coffee and a circle of believers. Everything is at your fingertips and you do not have to go any further to experience all the charms of an Adriatic summer atmosphere!

Tisno's thoroughfare allows you to explore

Tisno is the place where Murter Island almost touches the mainland, where only a narrow and tight channel separates it from the shore. This is what gave Tisno its name: (Tisno means tight).


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




Tribunj is a typical Dalmatian settlement with narrow streets and densely built houses. The historic core of the settlement was built on an islet and a stone bridge built afterwards connects the islet with the mainland where a new settlement developed.

The oldest written documents date from 1463. Tribunj was called Tribunj at that time. The settlement was fortified by defensive walls during the Venetian rule, and the

remnants of the walls are still visible.

Accommodation is offered in private apartments, rooms and pensions of the highest quality, and the nautical port "Danuvius" is located in the centre of the settlement's harbour.

Tribunj is a peaceful oasis for artists, but also a pleasant place for vacations. Among all the events, the traditional fishermen's parties and the donkey race are especially emphasized.

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

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
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














25 minutes from Šibenik lies a hidden gem of our coast - the island of Zlarin. It is most known for the tradition of coral harvesting and processing dating back to the 15th century, and this tradition is still preserved today. The knowledge of coral harvesting was passed down from father to son and there are no actual written records of it, however, the knowledge of the tool used (so called inženj) was preserved by oral tradition. Folk costumes, traditional customs, songs and dances have also been preserved, and the islanders are very proud of them. That is why they often revive the rich intangible heritage at various events such as "Ispraćaj koraljara" (send-off of the coral harvesters), "Latinskin idrun na kureja" (traditional regatta) and "Ćakule" (a TV show about traditional cuisine). A large number of events are held during the summer, such as Brudetijadas (fish stew contests), Srdeladas (pilchard stew contests), World Mullet Fishing Championship "ciplov na teću" (the contestants catch the fish using pots), etc. with "Everyone is Welcome" as the summer program motto.

Cars are not allowed on the island, making it ideal for a relaxed vacation, families with small children and young people, taking walks, going swimming in the crystal clear sea and cycling. The port of Zlarin is popular among yachtsmen because of its location, while it is also home to the largest island waterfront in Croatia.










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












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
