


CENTRAL DALMATIA The Heart of Adriatic



In Croatia it is a punishable offence to camp in open spaces outside of registered campsites or parking lots for caravans and camper-vans.

If you want to visit a campsite during winter, we advise you to contact the campsite first to check the level of service provided during winter. The term mini campsite implies a campsite for up to 200 people, i.e., up to 70 camping units (parcels), that is generally open to campers as part of family estates.







The official currency in Croatia is the kuna (1 HRK = 100 lipas); Foreign currencies can be exchanged at banks, exchange offices, post offices, and most tourist agencies, hotels and campsites. Credit cards (Eurocard/Mastercard, Visa, American Express and Diners) are accepted in almost all hotels, marinas, restaurants and shops, as well as at ATMs.

MEDICAL SERVICE

Foreign tourists who have compulsory health care insurance do not pay for their emergency health care services during their stay in Republic of Croatia, if Croatia has concluded the health care agreement with the country they come from and provided they have the required verification demonstrating they have the right to health care for themselves.

Transferring pets across the border is possible only with the possession of all required documents indicating the current health state of the animal, provided by a veterinarian, and dogs and cats also need to have microchip implants. www.mps.hr

Jure (1762 m), the Marian Shrine Vepric at the entrance of Makarska and the shell collection in the Malacological Museum of the Franciscan Monastery in Makarska, the inside of the baroque summer mansion Kaštelet in Tučepi, Ethno-Eco Village Kokorići near Vrgorac, located in the riviera hinterland, behind Biokovo mountain.

Makarska's traditional almond dessert – *makarana* cake, fish, shellfish and crab dishes, local sage or flower honey from the slopes of the Biokovo, Makarska wines, and *bikla* (a mixture of red wine and milk) in Vrgorac.





The largest Dalmatian and third largest Adriatic island is Brač, with some twenty coastal and inland towns and villages offering the possibilities of both quiet and active holidays. It is also an island with a long tradition of stonemasonry and white stone working. This type of stone was used in the construction of the parliament buildings in Vienna and Budapest, the White House in Washington, DC, as well as the Diocletian's Palace in Split and the cathedrals in Trogir and Šibenik. Brač has excellent traffic connections via ferry and catamaran lines with Split and Makarska, which can be reached in less than an hour of a pleasant ride.


