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GOLDEN PEN 2023.

For the 19th time, the Croatian Tourist Board awarded the prestigious "Golden Pen" award to foreign travel journalists, bloggers and influencers for the best posts about Croatia as a tourist destination in the past year. The co-organizers and hosts of this year's award were the tourist community of the Šibenik-Knin County and the city of Šibenik, who for 32 foreign journalists, videographers, bloggers and influencers from as many as 18 countries such as Germany, Austria, Poland, France, Spain, the USA, Canada, China, Great Britain, etc. prepared a multi-day program of visiting destinations, sights and attractions from the area of the county, and in addition to cultural and natural attractions, they also enjoyed excellent local food and wine.

The "Golden Pen" award ceremony took place on April 20, 2023 in the beautiful surroundings of the Barone Fortress in Šibenik. Several representatives participated in five categories, i.e. winners for the best reportage in print or online media, the best radio reportage, the best television reportage, the best travel blog and the best post on social networks. In each category, the most important prize "Golden pens" - Grand Prix - was selected.

Let's add that during the program all the guests were entertained by Ivana Prgin from Šibenik with her inspiring jazz notes, and the artist Zvonimir Vila made sure that the awardees had a nice memory of this award, who made a statue of the award from over 100-year-old oak wood.

We also remind you that the Croatian Tourist Board and the tourist boards of Šibenik-Knin County and the city of Šibenik organized a special program of visiting destinations, sights and attractions from the county for foreign journalists, travel bloggers and influencers, as part of which they visited the city of Šibenik, Krka National Park with special emphasis on Roški waterfall, Skradinski Buk and Visovac, the fortress of St. Nikola, but also the Testament and Baraka wineries and the oyster farm Oyster22.

By awarding the "Golden Pen" for many years, the Croatian Tourist Board emphasizes the value of a professional approach to writing and reporting on Croatia in foreign media, and in this way wants to thank foreign journalists for their contribution to the promotion of Croatian tourism in the world.

HUNGARY

The amount of recorded material during our stay in Zadar County was too large for one 20-minute show, so as a result of this trip we ended up with two shows!
